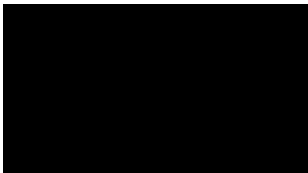
Our club is not for profit organisation, governed by an elected board and run by a wonderful group of volunteers. The fabric of our club is our local community,
