Dear Sir

I object to the current proposed South Western boundary of Moore containing the suburbs of Carine, Trigg, Marmion.

I propose this section of the boundary to be West along Beach Road as per the original boundary of Stirling.

I propose this on the basis of the following factors:

- keep together or improve existing communities of interest, in some cases represented by local government areas, suburbs and localities, where possible, and
- use strong and readily identifiable features as electoral division boundaries, to the extent possible.

The localities of Carine, Trigg, Marmion are more closely associated with localities of Karrinyup and neighbouring localities and would be better served by being represented by the same Federal member. Beach Road is a strong and readily identifiable feature.

Hence, these suburbs should be zoned as part of the new Curtin division.
