Dear Members of the augmented Electoral Commission,

As proposed, the western boundary of the division of Corangamite is now over 50 kilometres from both the eponymous lake and shire.

The Commission's 2017-2018 Victorian redistribution suggested changing the name of this division to better reflect the expansion of Wannon and contraction of Corangamite

My own suggestion would be the locally indigenous *Kunuwarre* or the anglicised *Connewarre*.

This would maintain the consistency of a lake being used to name a Division, now within its boundaries.
