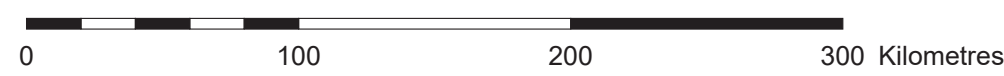

PROPOSED NAMES AND BOUNDARIES OF FEDERAL ELECTORAL DIVISIONS IN WESTERN AUSTRALIA

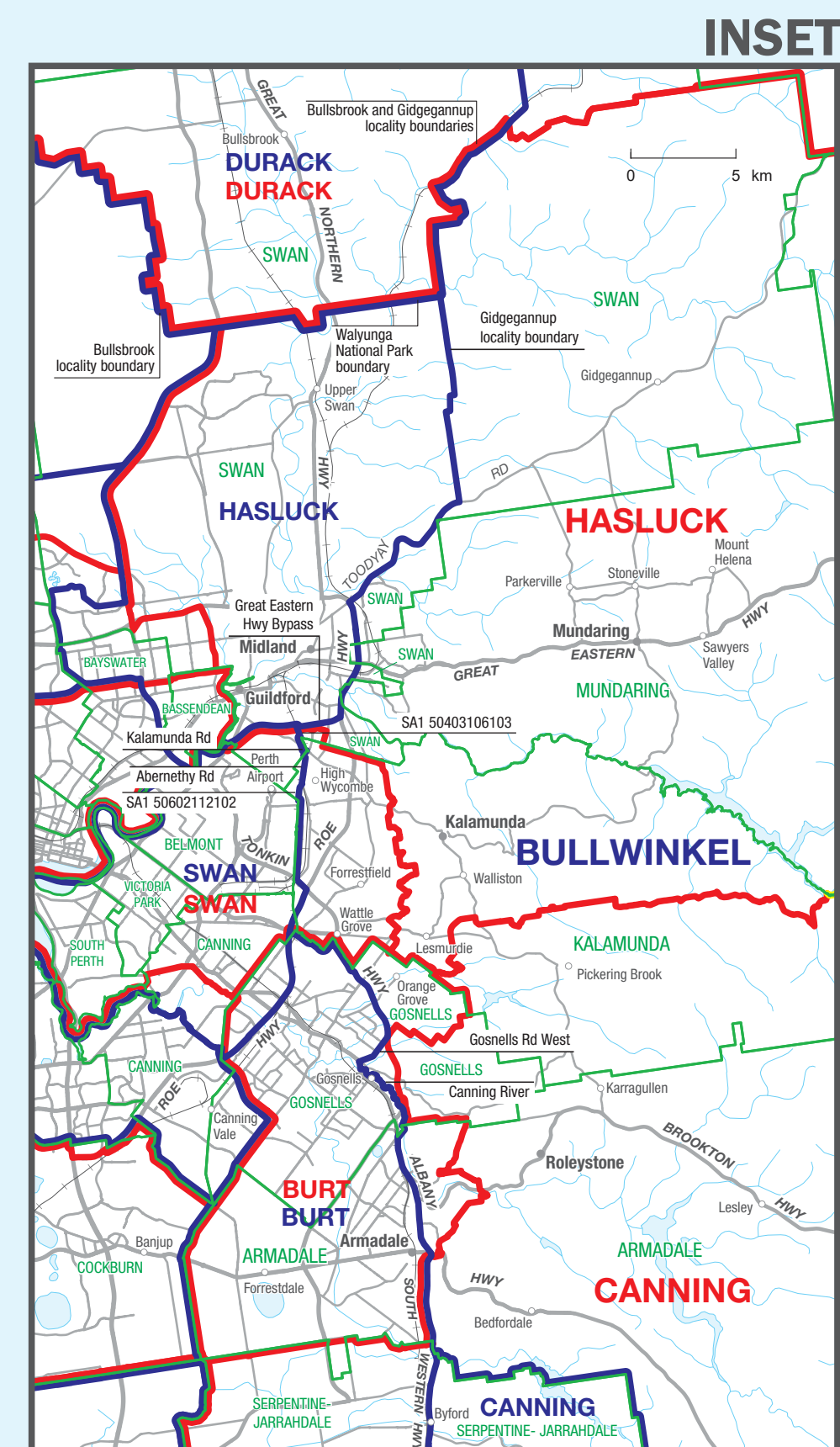
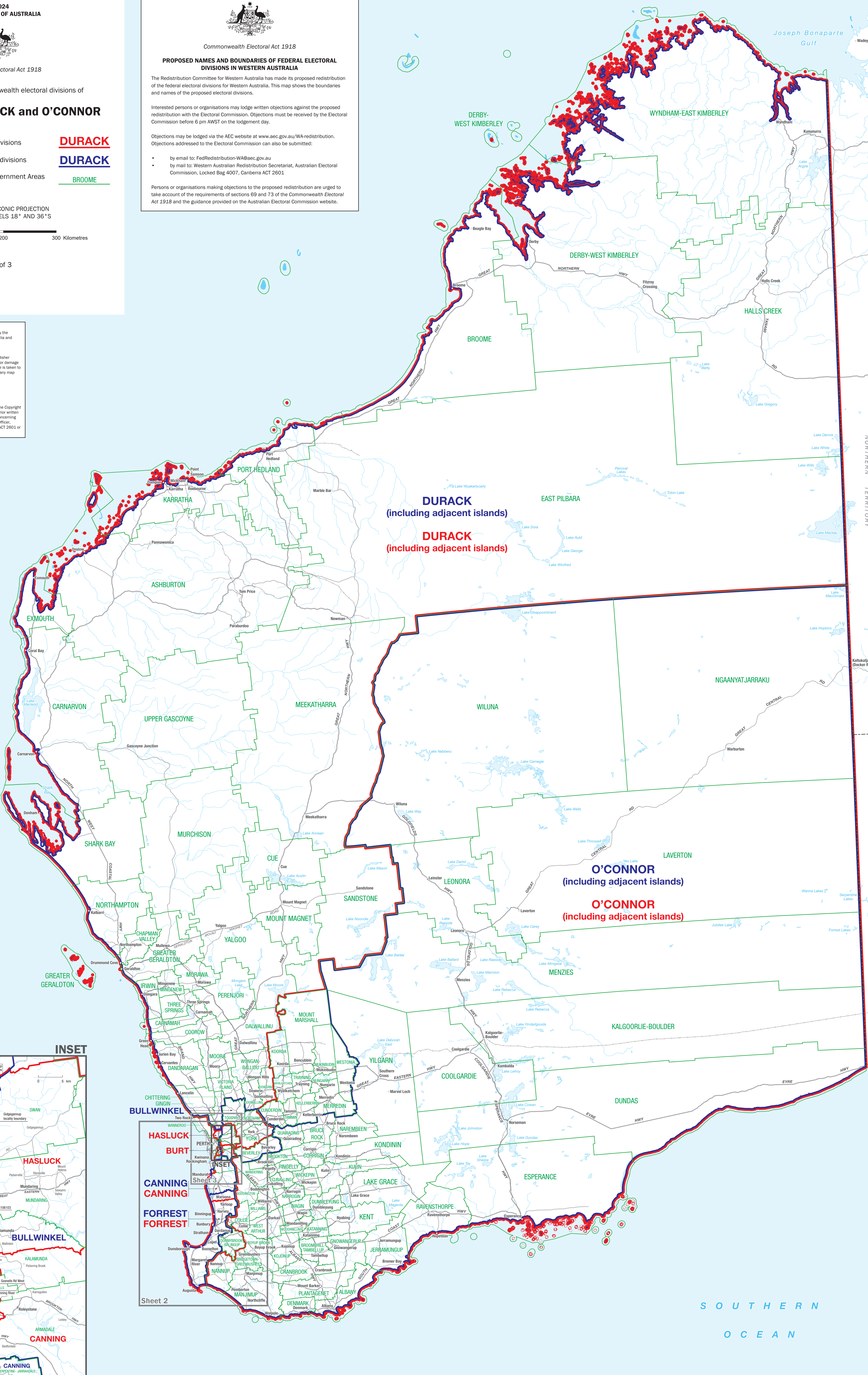
